TK - 4th Grade:

The Woodside Staff is looking forward to seeing your children on Wednesday, June 10th. Please plan on arriving within your grade level's designated window. *All families should park and join the queue along the front of the 1st grade classrooms, adjacent to the parking lot. You will enter campus through the gate between the tennis courts and the 1st grade classrooms.* There will be social distancing markers to help separate families. A staff member will move families through the line, directing them to the correct grade level classroom.

From there, families will wait until it is their turn to approach the classroom table. If your child's teacher has given students **books or other classroom materials**, please bring those with your child's name on a piece of paper or Post-It and we will have a place for you to drop them off. If you have **library books**, please bring them during drop off. If you checked out a **Chromebook**, please return it and the charger during drop off on the blacktop next to the Music and PE teachers.
