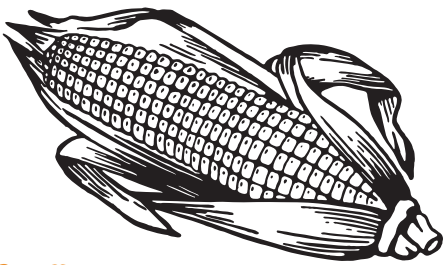

Soon the sweet, buttery **Packham's Triumph** pear; the crisp, miniature **Forelle**; and the super juicy **Comice** will be waking up from their slumber.
