

2018 May Day – 3rd Grade

Dear Parents/Guardians of the 3rd grade students,

On **Saturday, May 5th**, the students will be performing their May Day Dance. They have been working hard and spending a great deal of time rehearsing with their partners. The children are excited about the upcoming performance and have been awarded a special honor to have NEW costumes for this 96th Year of May Day!

In order for the children to be well prepared for the dances they will need to bring in the following items by **Mon., April 30 to their classroom teacher.**

BOYS

- Dress/Button Up-WHITE SHIRT – with no print
- DARK PANTS (preferable BLACK, lightweight)
- SHOES (dark sneakers, preferably)
- Their MAY DAY costume provided by the school is a bow tie & suspenders. These will be held at school & collected after the dance. Suspenders/Bow Ties will match the girls' outfits. These following pictures are to give you an example image of what is expected:



GIRLS

- BLACK T-Shirt – with no print (please note the girls in the picture are wearing spaghetti strap tops – I would prefer a T-shirt)
- Black SOCKS
- BLACK or DARK TENNIS SHOES (Sneakers, preferably)
- BLACK LEGGINS
- Provided by the school - tutu, hair clip, & wand. Images are provided to help give you an example of what is expected:



*****All CLOTHING should be on a HANGER & LABELED clearly with the CHILD'S NAME and shoes should be in a bag clearly labeled with the child's name. *****
