Woodside School Student Dance Permission Form

Participants must agree to the following rules:

- \$15 will be collected from each student before gaining entrance to the dance
- Each Woodside School student is allowed to bring one guest
- All students must remain on the premises for the duration of the activity
- A responsible adult must pick up students at the end of the event
- Students are expected to abide by the Woodside School behavior policy
- **Students who do not follow the Woodside School dress code will call their parents for a change of clothes before being admitted to the dance. Please refer to the following school dress code guidelines:**
 - Clothing that reveals underwear or cleavage, bare chests, bare stomachs (midriffs), and bare backs, is not permitted
 - Underwear, including bra straps, must be kept under regular garments
 - Waistbands on pants should be high enough to allow student to bend over without exposing underwear
 - Attire promoting alcohol, drugs, or sex is not permitted
 - Shorts should be at least knuckle length with arms straight at your side
 - Skirts should be at least fingertip length with arms straight at your side

Doors open at 7:00 p.m. and close at 7:15 p.m. No students will be permitted into the dance after 7:15 p.m., and students are expected to remain at the dance for the duration (9:30 p.m.). The following contact information is required for all students to participate in any Woodside School activity. A signature represents agreement with the rules and releases any associated individual or group from all liability.
