If you are waiting to complete your 2nd dose, please wait until you've received your dose before entering the information.

Our infectious disease experts recommend everyone who's offered a vaccine receive it. This includes people with most allergies, those who are pregnant or breastfeeding, and especially those with high risk medical conditions.

COVID-19 vaccines are by appointment only



You will need an appointment for both your first and second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. The vaccines are safe and effective. We recommend all eligible people get vaccinated.



Vaccine supplies are limited. We're distributing vaccines to eligible groups as defined by state guidelines. As supplies increase and new groups become eligible for vaccination, we'll let you know at the website below.
