

Unplugged and Focused: Woodside School Device Guidelines

Woodside School prioritizes an enriching educational experience by minimizing digital distractions. These guidelines outline which devices are restricted, how they must be stored, and the specific consequences for unauthorized use during school hours.

Usage & Storage Expectations

Off and Away in Backpacks

Devices must be turned off and stored in backpacks for the entire school day.



Restricted Devices

Includes cell phones, smartwatches, tablets, e-readers, laptops, and gaming or video devices.



Smartwatches in "School Mode"

Watches must be configured as simple watches and cannot be used for texting/calling.

Protocols & Consequences



Use the Front Office Phone

Students must use the office phone to contact home; parents should call the office.



No Network Access

Personal devices are not permitted to connect to the school network.



Unauthorized devices are held in the office until dismissal based on a three-tier warning system.

Violation Level

Release Protocol

1 1st Warning



Released to the student at dismissal.

2 2nd Warning



Released to the student by the Principal.

3 3rd Warning



Released only to a parent or guardian.
