- **PTA:**

 - As long as the teachers have enough notice, this can work
 - This is the best way for kids to have the same access
 - How does the group feel about donations:
 - Some of these supplies can be simple
 - Catnip, socks, hygiene materials
 - Using SignUp Genius with links to Amazon orders
 - Donations could be done through directed donations or sponsor an event to purchase the supplies for a particular event
 - **Walks/Coffees (WIDC Members)**
 - How can we make sure that these walks are during times and at places where it's accessible for all school groups
 - Right now they are geared towards new families and are at 8:30 a.m.
 - So far: two coffees/one walk
 - Have events in more accessible areas for all stakeholders - maybe create a calendar and plan out the coffee talks/walks/which ones are with admin and which ones are just with the families
 - One out of every three outside of Woodside
 - Offer carpool/transportation

- Have PTA create a calendar and then the PTA sends it to admin and the admin can plug in availability
 - Planning indoor events for later this year is a possibility
- With these events: what do parents want?
 - Start with a topic to get the group going and then let the it develop organically
 - Once the calendar is created, look at what events or happenings occur during that time and tailor conversations around those things
- Idea: some of these could be to celebrate family cultures and traditions or for a way to plan for school events where families could work together to create presentations or events for classes to sign up for:
 - Could bring this to the school/in the classroom for classes to sign up to learn more about family traditions or cultures
 - Start by asking the community how many countries we represent
 - Could be done in a week/like a science fair
