Facilities Needs



- **Repair/Replace** leaking roofs, outdated heating, cooling, and HVAC systems.
- **Stabilize** and repair creek erosion due to winter rains/flooding.
- **Update** classrooms to meet current educational standards.
- Install backup systems, including solar and batteries, to help power essential needs in an emergency
- Improve safety with security cameras and exterior lighting.
- **Replace** and renovate kindergarten classrooms.
- **Ensure** playfields/courts/facilities are safe and open for community recreation use.
- Install/acquire modifications necessary for emergencies, including possible use by emergency personnel/agencies and a community gather center as needed.



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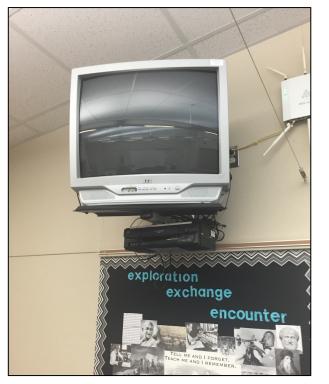
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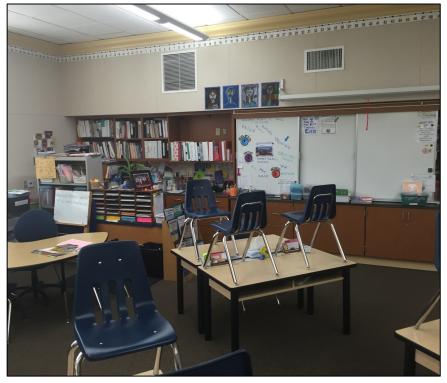
