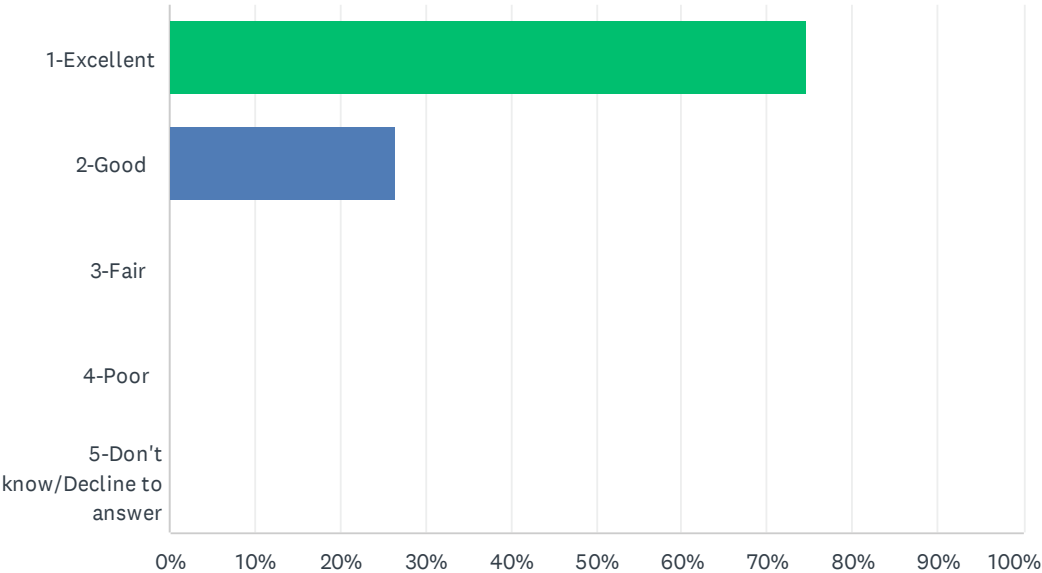


Q1 Overall, how would you rate WESD's performance in providing a well-rounded education?

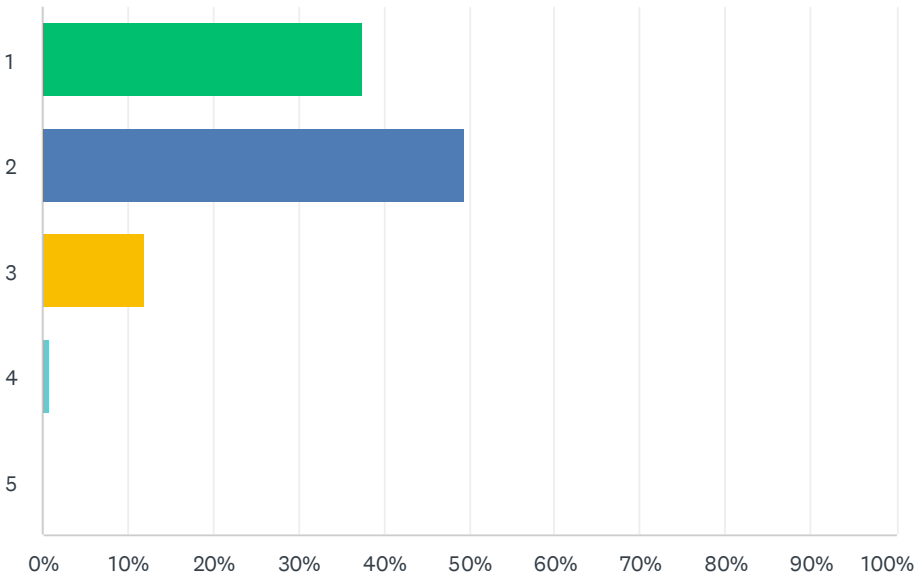

Q2 How many children do you have attending WES?

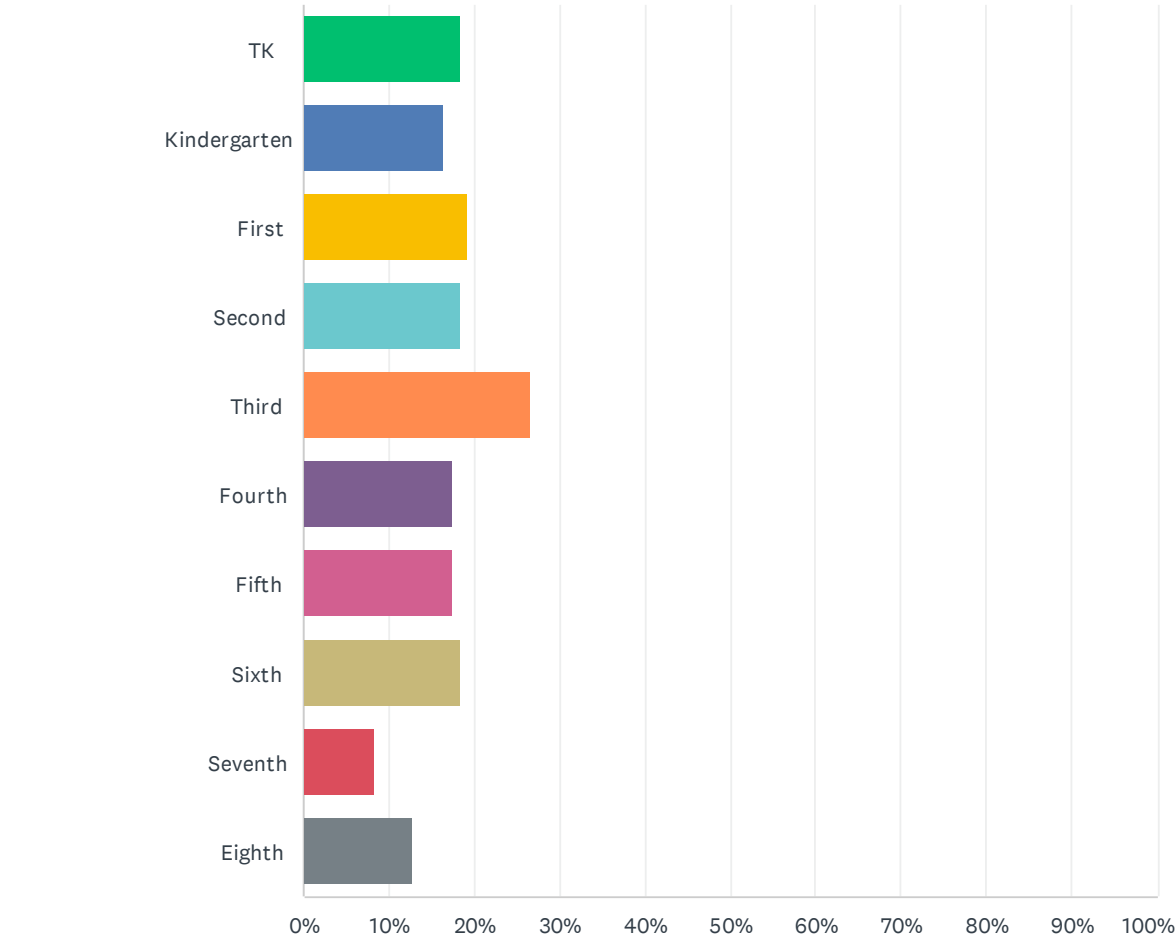

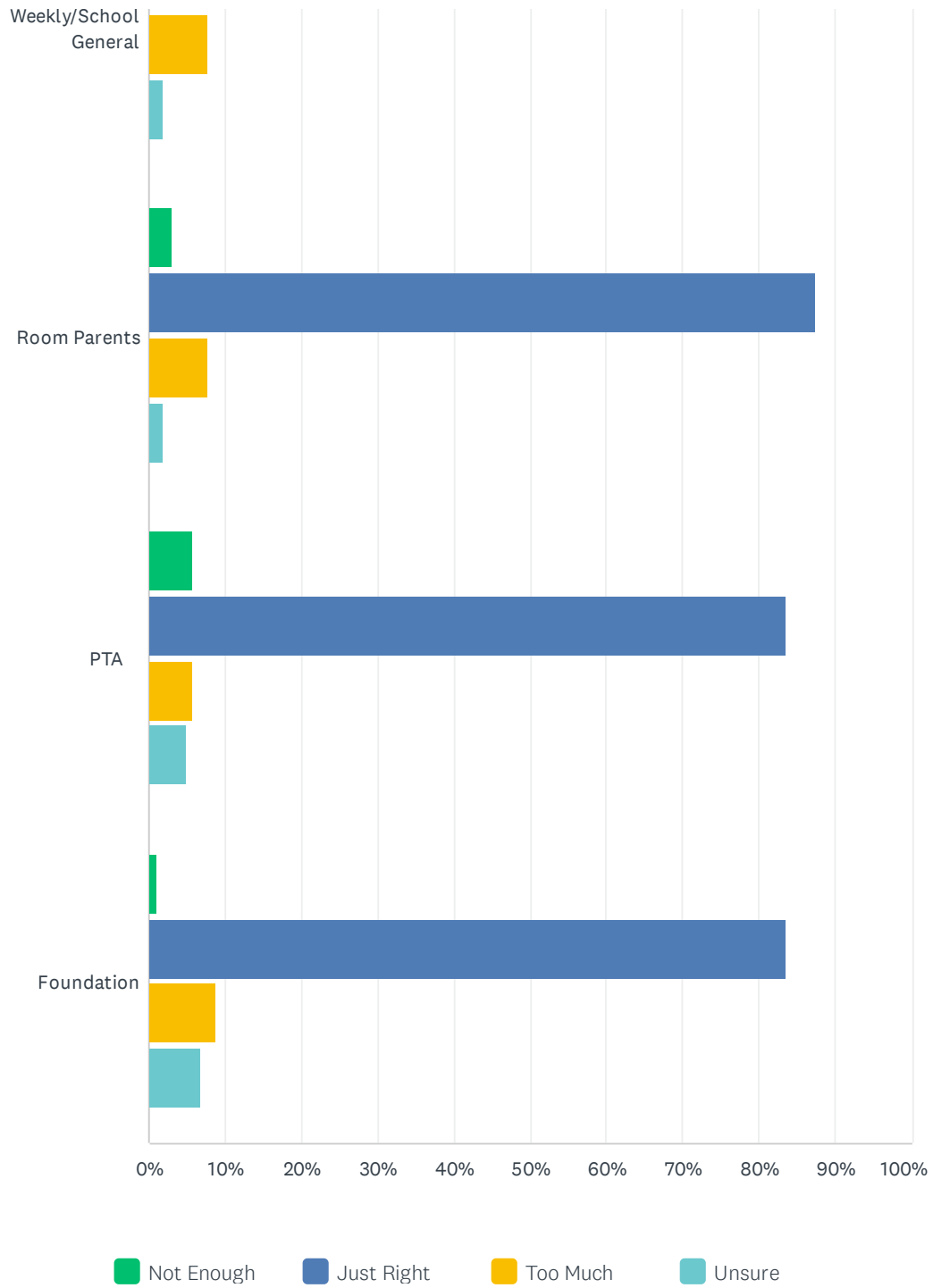
Q5 CommunicationsHow do you feel about the quantity of communications from the following:
