It's time to dust off your dancing shoes and get groovy! This year, we're capturing our school's memories with the glitter, energy, and funk of the 1970s disco era. We need a cover design that is dyn-o-mite, and we're calling on you to create it!

Your mission is to design the front cover for the Woodside 2025-2026 Yearbook!

Theme: Wildcat Disco Fever!

This is your chance to turn our school into the ultimate disco party. Think about the vibrant energy of Woodside. What makes our school year shine? Let's see it reflected on a cover inspired by the days of disco balls, light-up dance floors, and funky music.

Theme Inspiration (Ideas to get you started):

- **The Disco Wildcat:** Imagine our Woodside Wildcat mascot ready to hit the dance floor! Is it wearing bell bottoms and platform shoes? Is it striking a groovy pose?
- 70s Style: Use classic disco and 70s elements like:
 - Sparkling disco balls
 - o Funky, bubbly, or psychedelic fonts
 - Vibrant color palettes (think oranges, yellows, purples, and browns)
 - Silhouettes of students dancing
 - Starbursts and geometric patterns

Required Elements (The "Must-Haves"): Your design *must* include the following text:

- The school name: "Woodside Wildcats" or "Woodside School"
- The school year: "2025-2026"
- The title should be **bold**, **solid**, **and stand out**.

Technical Specifications:

- Size: Your artwork must be 8.5" x 11" and vertically oriented (portrait).
- Format: We will accept both hand-drawn and digital submissions.



- Draw the picture in a "portrait" layout, up and down
- Make sure you fill the whole space by having a background behind anything in your picture. (No white space)
- Your name written lightly in pencil on the BACK of the page.

How to Submit: You may bring your completed cover design to the front office (make sure your name is on the back!)

Deadline: Your work should be submitted to the office by Tuesday, November 4th.
