

Yearbook Cover

Theme: #PicturePerfect

Interested in designing a yearbook cover this year? Create a picture that represents our theme #pictureperfect.

This could look like a Wildcat enjoying some of the major events on campus, like May Day, Field Day, or one of the amazing musical performances! They could be taking pictures of the event or participating in them. It's all about celebrating the many traditions we have here on campus! We're looking for a creative cover picture that will include the words "Woodside School", "Wildcats", and "2026-2027".

-Requirements-

- The title of the yearbook will be "Woodside School" or "Woodside Wildcats" and MUST be part of your design.
- If not used in the title, the word "Wildcats" must appear somewhere in the picture.
- The title should be **solid, bold, and stand out**.
 - *It's also better if this can be centered from side to side near the top portion of the picture, at least ¾ of an inch from the top.*
- The years "2026-2027" must appear somewhere in the picture.
- The picture should cover 8½ x 11 inches of plain white paper, anything outside those dimensions may not make it on the cover.
- Draw the picture in a "portrait" layout, *up and down*
- Make sure you fill the whole space by having a background behind anything in your picture. (*No white space*)
- Your name and grade level written **lightly in pencil on the BACK of the page**. We will not use your picture if your name is on the front.

We recommend you put a Wildcat on the cover to show school spirit.

Use prior yearbooks as examples (available in the Library and front office).

If you need paper, we have cardstock for you. Stop by the art room or the office if you need additional supplies.
