

# Yearbook Cover Contest

## Theme: Camp Wildcat

If you are interested in designing a yearbook cover this year, create a picture that represents our theme: Camp Wildcat. Our theme covers all things related to camping or going to camp: bonfires, activities, tents, etc. You can make up a camp scene or a collage of different aspects of camping or going to camp.

### -Yearbook Cover Requirements-

- The title of the yearbook will be “**Woodside School**” or “**Woodside Wildcats**” and **MUST** be part of your picture.
- If not used in the title, the word “**Wildcats**” **must** appear somewhere in the picture.
- The **title** should be **solid, bold, and stand out**.
  - *It's also better if this can be centered from side to side near the top*
- The years “**2022-2023**” **must** appear somewhere in the picture.
- The picture should cover **8½ x 11** on plain white paper, anything outside those dimensions may not make it on the cover. You can stop by the office to pick up some cardstock for your picture.
- Draw the picture in “**portrait**” layout, *up and down*
- Make sure you **fill the whole space** by having a background behind anything in your picture. (*No white space*)
- Your name and grade written **lightly in pencil on the BACK of the page**. We will not use your picture if your name is on the front.
- You **MAY NOT** use any copyrighted text or images on your cover or we cannot accept it.

We recommend you put a **Wildcat** on the cover to show school spirit.

Use prior yearbooks as examples.

Pictures should be school-appropriate.
