All Woodside School students and guests must follow the Woodside School dress code and behavior policy. Any student who does not follow these rules will be turned away on the night of the dance. In addition, **students must enter the dance no later than 7:15 pm and must remain at the dance until it ends (9:30pm).**

All Woodside students and guests must fill out a permission form in order to attend the dance. Students only need to turn in one dance permission form for the entire school year. **Dance permission forms for Woodside students should be returned to the office no later than 3:10 p.m. on Friday, October 29th.** Students who fail to meet this deadline will not be allowed to attend the dance. Please note that masks will be required both indoors and outdoors during the dance.

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Woodside School Student Dance Permission Form
