## **FACILITIES UPDATE (Superintendent Steve Frank)**

Construction is underway for Room 15 with framing in progress. Trenching and boring will begin over spring break near the kinder track. TK and Kinder demolition starts June 13th, after school ends. The preschool entrance will be relocated, impacting the playground. New e-bike regulations are in effect due to safety concerns (broken windows, charging issues). E-bikes are prohibited from being ridden on campus, with designated parking racks being installed by the music rooms. The Foundation is exploring cafeteria construction using seed money, with 10 designers consulted and site visits completed.

# **AUCTION UPDATE (Foundation Vice-President Beth Nash)**

The annual auction is approaching with cocktails at 5:30pm and live auction at 7pm. Approximately 250 seats are available with seating grouped by families/grades. The event typically sells out two weeks in advance. Buy your tickets!

#### FINANCIAL REPORTS & FUNDRAISING

**Deposits:** \$6,982 received, including \$1,076 from Spiritwear, \$851 for May Day, and Honeybear fundraiser profits. Sixth-grade movie fundraiser payments expected by April 16th. **Payables:** Approximately \$733 for Karaoke night reimbursement and teacher programming costs. PTA approved nearly \$9,000 in grants this year for classroom needs, including jerseys, tables, microscopes, and equipment replacement. Spiritwear sales are performing well. Read-a-thon exceeded goals despite website glitches.
