DISTRICT UPDATES AND ANNOUNCEMENTS (Superintendent Steve Frank)

Bicycle & E-bike Safety

- E-bikes are prohibited on campus; off-campus parking is designated.
- Students may only ride Class 1 & 2 e-bikes (no speedometers).
- E-scooters require permits or a driver's license.
- Students must walk bikes on paths and avoid narrow construction areas.

Facilities & Strategic Planning

- New kindergarten classroom foundation is complete; framing is scheduled for October.
- Excavation uncovered footings from a previous building.
- Parking remains limited due to increased staff.
- Strategic plan includes a new mathematics framework and upcoming AI usage guidelines.

ANNUAL FUND UPDATE (Foundation President Beth Nash)

Annual Fund Campaign kicks off October 21st with Gratitude Event at the Hub (5:30-7:30pm, babysitting available). The annual auction provides 15% of the school budget; raised \$2.5M last year. Grand Auction scheduled for May 16th.

ORIGINAL ART PROGRAM (Art Teacher Amy Harmon)

- Program provides funding for school's art supplies.
- This year's theme: food, meals, and traditions.
- Preview magnets and order information will be sent home in the first week of October.
- Order deadline: October 17th; delivery by November 21st.

BUDGET & FINANCIAL MATTERS

- **2025-26 PTA Budget approved:** \$76K (break-even goal with 3% cost-of-living increase).
- Membership goal: 110 families and 15 staff.
- **Class funds** now managed by PTA in separate account; reimbursement forms available at the office.
- Surplus funds will support the 8th-grade Operetta and expenses for that cohort.
